Driving here

From I-71 southbound

Take exit 108B onto E Broad Street and turn left. Continue east for a little over 2 miles. Turn left onto Parkview Avenue and drive approximately ¼ mile.

From I-71 northbound

Follow I-71 northbound signs through the I-71 / I-70 split merging left to exit 101A. In ½ mile, take exit 108B, turning right onto Broad Street. Continue east for a little over 2 miles. Turn left onto Parkview Avenue and drive approximately ¼ mile.

From I-70 westbound

Before reaching the I-70/I-71 split, take exit 103B onto Livingston Avenue (US-33). Turn left onto East Livingston Avenue and in ¼ mile turn right onto S Nelson Road. Follow Nelson for about 1 ½ miles then turn right onto Broad Street. Go approximately half a mile to traffic light at Parkview Avenue. Turn left onto Parkview Avenue and drive approximately ¼ mile.

From I-70 eastbound

Follow the I-70 eastbound signs through the I-70/I-71 split to take exit 101A on the left onto the East Innerbelt north (toward I-670 west, Cleveland). In ½ mile, take exit 108B onto Broad Street (US-40). Continue east for a little over 2 miles. Turn left onto Parkview Avenue and drive approximately ¼ mile.

NOTE: Watch for construction and detours at multiple stretches of I-70 and I-71, OH-315, I-670, and other highways. The preceding directions may be obsolete due to construction detours. Check pavingtheway.org or MapQuest for updates on construction.

Parking here

The driveway into the grounds of Jeffrey Mansion will take you to the front of the house and a circular drive where you can drop off passengers and food.

A handicapped ramp is located at the front of the mansion and a small wheelchair ramp enters through french doors on the south portico. A very small parking lot is available on the north side of the circular drive, and we ask

that this be reserved for severely handicapped and those bringing equipment and supplies.

You may park on Parkview Avenue as well as Commonwealth Park Avenue immediately in front of the mansion. It is a short walk up the drive to the mansion. Two smaller lots behind the mansion can be accessed off of Clifton Avenue. You can walk up to the back of the mansion from these lots. *Please observe all parking signs as you will be ticketed by the Bexley police for parking illegally.*

Sleeping here
